
What is respect?
Why is respect so important?




Respect

Basic expectations...

- Everyone takes part.
- We try our best.
- We are here to help each other.



Respect shows we are mature and care about learning.





What does respect look like?

(What can you do to show respect)

Example:

- Sit properly for lessons.
- Raise your hand when you want to speak.
- Be kind to each other.
- Keep focussed on the lesson.
- Looking at the screen.
- Simple backgrounds.
- Having the camera on.
- Being on time.






What does respect sound like?

(How we should speak)

Example:

- Letting others finish what they say.
- Look at the screen when someone is talking.
- Be quiet when others are talking.
- Don't interrupt.
- Think about what people say.
- Nice language. "To add to.." "I heard what Alice said, but I think..."
- Listen to everybody!
